

## Rules and Regulations

For classes offered in the traditional classroom setting:

### Attendance

Because summer school meets for 19 days a semester, the attendance procedures are different from the regular school year. Students will be put on an attendance contract after missing four hours of class time. A student will be dismissed for a semester from summer school after missing over eight hours of class time per semester. The parent/guardian is responsible for calling the school by 7:45 A.M. on the day of a student's absence. There are no waivers or extensions in summer school. One-semester courses may not be taken over the duration of two semesters.

### Tardies

Students must be in their classrooms by 8:00 A.M. If a student is more than five minutes late to class, he/she must report to the summer school office. Tardies in excess of five minutes will be counted as one hour of absence. Three tardies of less than five minutes each will count as one hour of absence.

### Dress

Normal FCHS rules apply. Students are not to wear hats in the building.

### Discipline

Specific rules will be explained the first day of school. Failure to abide by expected conduct will result in suspension and/or dismissal. A student who is dismissed from summer school loses credit and tuition.

### Non-Floyd County Residents

Students who do not reside in Floyd County will be charged a fee of \$403.38 per semester.

### For online classes for retake only:

- \* Report first day to registrar and obtain passwords. Plan to stay the entire day.
  - \* You are required to take all assessments at school.
  - \* You must finish the course during the summer semester in which you are enrolled.
  - \* The fee for online classes is \$25.00.
- For free/reduced lunch students the fee is waived.
